Herbert Sklenar served as the Chairman and CEO of Vulcan Materials Company in Birmingham, Alabama from 1992 until his retirement in 1997. This capped a 25-year career at Vulcan Materials that included positions as Chief Operating Officer, Executive Vice President, and Chief Administrative Officer. On his retirement in 1997 he was elected Chairman of the Board Emeritus of the company.

Previously Mr. Sklenar worked at the Cudahy Company in Phoenix, Arizona, the Boise-Cascade Corporation in Boise, Idaho, and the Marmac and Parkersburg-Aetna Corporations in Parkersburg, West Virginia.

He has served in numerous capacities in local, state, and national civic, business, and educational organizations. Currently he is a member of the Advisory Board of the National Czech & Slovak Museum and Library, a Director/Trustee of Birmingham-Southern College, Leadership Birmingham, and the Birmingham Committee on Foreign Relations.

He has received the Alumni Achievement Award from The University of Nebraska at Omaha, the N.M.A. Silver Knight of Management Award, and the Brotherhood Award, National Conference of Christians and Jews. In 1997 he was elected to the Alabama Academy of Honor, and in 1997 he received the A.E.I. Gala Honoree.
